Evanne Browne is Founder and Artistic Director of Seicento Baroque Ensemble, Colorado's only choir specializing in the historically-informed performance of 17th and 18th century music. Seicento regularly performs music of Monteverdi and his contemporaries as well as the later Baroque music of Purcell and Handel and lesser known gems such as the Biber *Requiem* and Schütz *Musikalische Exequien*. This ensemble of 25 singers plus period instrument orchestra formed after the highly successful performance of Monteverdi's *Vespers of 1610* Evanne conducted in 2010, the first documented performance of the *Vespers* in Colorado.

Ms. Browne is also Director of Music at Boulder's First United Methodist Church and section leader of Ars Nova Singers. She studied Baroque performance practices at the Sweelinck Conservatory in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, and holds a Master of Music degree from the Shepherd School of Music at Rice University.
