

## Ronald Gibbs, MD



Born and educated in Philadelphia, Dr. Ronald Gibbs is an Obstetrician Gynecologist and served as Professor and Chair of that department at University of Colorado School of Medicine from 1989-2009. He is now Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Associate Dean for Continuing Medical Education and Professional Development, University of Colorado School of Medicine.

From his boyhood days, he developed a passion for early American history and for the history of discovery. Dr. Gibbs has a prominent collection of original maps

dating from the Revolutionary War. He has made occasional presentations on these topics to widely ranging audiences, including The Academy (photo above).
